- Types of Support: Single Project Support that must engage youth on [Global Youth Service Day](#), April 15-17.
- Priorities: Programs for youth service, projects that address issues of waste, habitat, climate, and water.
- Request: \$500
- Deadline: March 10, 2011
- Guidelines: Take Eligibility Quiz and then complete Online Application

ING Run for Something Better School Program

- Types of Support: Program Development
- Priorities: Programs that establish a school-based running program or expand on an existing one. Grants will be available for grades K-8th, however program will **not** be considered eligible if there are not a minimum of 25 students in grades 4th-8th in order to supply PACER data. The program must be offered a minimum of 2 days/week if it is a before or after school program. If a program is held during school time (i.e., P.E. class), the program must be offered a minimum of 3 days/week
- Request: \$2,500
- Deadline: May 1, 2011
- Guidelines: Complete Online Application

2011 Impact Fund

Types of Support: Program Development, Operating Budget, and Capacity Building

Priorities: Support youth-serving organizations with the resources they need to get underserved youth connected to the outdoors. Organizations must have an annual operating budget of \$250,000 or more and must have been in operation for over a year to be eligible.

Request: \$15,000 - \$50,000

Deadline: March 11, 2011 for Round 1 / June 10, 2011 for Round 2

Guidelines: Complete Online Eligibility Quiz and Online Application

2011 Catalyst Fund

Types of Support: Program Development, Operating Budget, and Capacity Building

Priorities: Supports organizations that connect underserved youth with outdoor experiences within or near their communities Organizations must have an annual operating budget of less than \$250,000 to be eligible.

Request: \$15,000

Deadline: April 18, 2011

Guidelines: Complete Online Eligibility Quiz and Online Application
